RUSSIA BEGINNING TO SUFFER FROM FOOD SCARCITY. Meats and Their Derivatives Almost Unobtainable in Cities, Says American Metals Agent.

Russia is beginning to suffer acutely from a scarcity of provisions, especially meats of all kinds, butter, lard and oils, according to Oscar Duplessis, an American engineer who has arrived in New York from Petrograd and other Russian cities. Mr. Duplessis has been in Russia for the past two years as the representative of a large American metal company and has travelled in all parts of the empire.

Meat-Lines at 2 A.M. He says that meats of all kinds and their derivatives are almost unobtainable in Petrograd and other Russian cities. Not infrequently lines begin to form in front of the butcher shops as early as 2 o'clock in the morning, women even bringing blankets and sleeping in the streets in order to be among the first when the shops open. Not infrequently, too, this long vigil is in vain, for the reason that the shopkeepers are unable to get meats at all. In such cases there are no disorders, however, women taking their disappointment in the stolid Russian way.

Traveling in Russia at present is anything but pleasant, as the railways are entirely in the hands of the military, and troop trains have precedence over all others. Schedules there are none, and a trip between towns only a hundred miles may take several days or even a week. Passenger trains are often kept on a siding for many hours at a time without explanation, and then proceed a few miles only to stop again.

"Made in America" In spite of these discomforts, Mr. Duplessis says, the country is alive with American goods, and the inevitable in the smiling way common to the "knights of the grip." They are selling everything from locomotives to toys, all "made in America."

There is a rushing business in spite of the fact that no one can say when deliveries can be made. Before the war many branches of trade were entirely in the hands of the Germans, and it is this trade that the American drummers are trying to capture.
