

The Burlingame Treaty.

Hong Kong, Aug. 4, via London 25.—The Peking Government refuses to ratify the convention concluded by Mr. Burlingame and the Chinese Embassy with the United States. Mr. J. Ross Brown, late American Minister to China, in reply to the Address of the British and American residents in Shanghai, denounced Mr. Burlingame's policy, and he considered it an evidence of the Chinese disinclination for progress. He declared the establishment of foreign relations with China on a basis of equality impossible at present, and thought the yielding attitude of the Foreign Powers would tend to produce war, as revelations lately made proved the mistaken nature of the British policy. The Chinese text of Mr. Burlingame's credentials differs from the foreign version. In the former he is appointed Envoy of China to tributary nations.
