

On the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and Mines, His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to order that the cutting of timber on any Crown Land within the following area be prohibited, except for firewood, for the purposes of the fishery, or for building and other purposes in connection with farming operations. The area above referred to is described and bounded as follows:—

All that piece and parcel of land bounded on the South East by the Bay Bulls Road, and extending along said road from Doyle's Bridge seven miles more or less towards Bay Bulls; thence running South Westerly seven miles more or less at right angles to the general trend of the said Bay Bulls Road; thence about North Westerly seven miles more or less; and thence in a straight line seven miles more or less to the place of commencement. Containing forty-nine square miles more or less.
