### Lengthy Tunnels.

Although the Otira Tunnel in New ealand, opened recently, is officially stated to be the longest in the British Empire, it is easily beaten in this respect by several Continental tunnels. The Simplon, for instance, through the Alps, measures 121/4 miles in length, as compared with Otira's 5% miles, and is the longest in the world. Next comes the St. Gothard, 91/2 miles; the Mont Cenis 8 miles; and the Arlberg, 61/2 miles. The longest in the British Isles is the Severt Tunnel, 41/3 miles, which brings Cardiff and South Wales into close communication with Bristol and the South of England.


