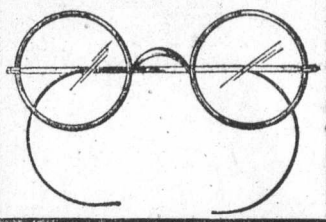

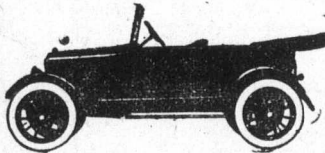

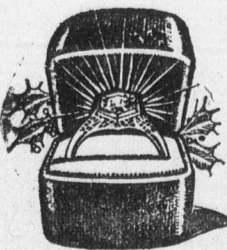
Dear Santa Claus: I would like if
