The financial condition of the diocese renders it simply impossible to impose either of these two offerings, in addition to those already required for diocesan and missionary purposes. The falling off in the latter, as shown by this Report, is largely due to the increased demands made on the people for the stipends of the clergy, and other objects.

N.B.—Blanks in the above Report are attributable either (1) to a vacancy in the mission, or (2) to the poverty of the people, disqualifying them as it does, in not a few instances, for the payment even of the quota promised towards the missionary's stipend, or (3) to the blameworthy neglect of the clergyman to announce and emphasize the customary special offertories.
