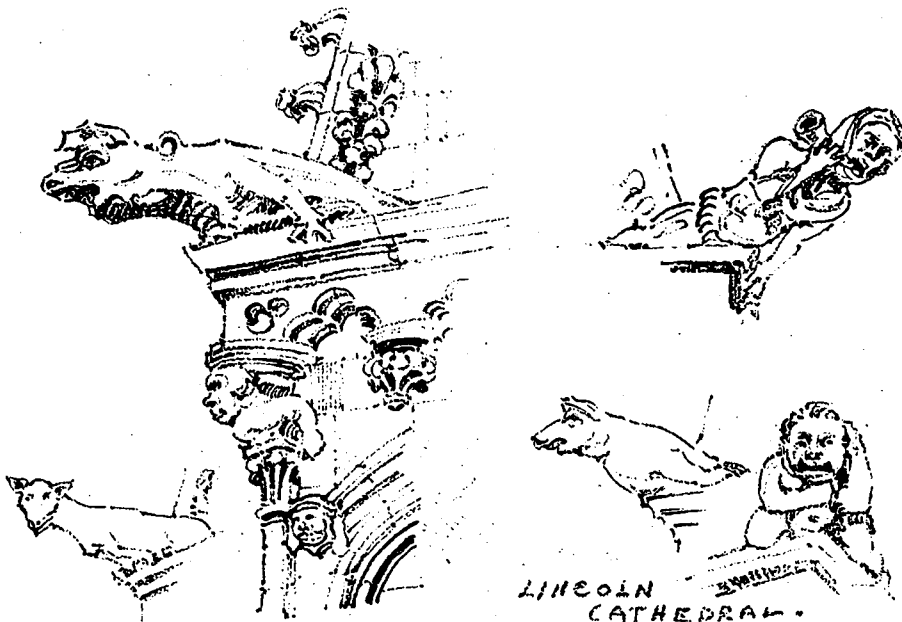




OLD HOUSES, HIGH PETERGATE, YORK, ENGLAND.
