Commission of 28 December 1956 issued by H.H. Prince
Sounans Phonnes, Prime Minister of the Royal Government
and H.H. Prince Soubhapourou, Representative of the
Royal Police.

The Commission summoned delegations from both sides for making
efforts in order to conclude easily these if the statements sign-
ed already, and at the same time spreading the
declaration of cessation of democatic statements for the people
and organization since some time could also be settled by
means of discussion in the future.

Finally, the Commission started discussions on
the political programme of the Royal Government
and jointly saw the need for settling the discussions towards
a complete settlement.

The discussions of the Commission took place in su
stensibly meeting the conditions of the Royal Government.
