- (d) the need, if any, for confidentiality and the reasons therefore; and
- (e) any time-limit within which compliance with the request is desired.

2. To the extent necessary and possible, requests for assistance shall also contain the following information:

- (a) the identity, nationality and location of the person or persons who are the subject of the investigations or proceedings;
- (b) details of any particular procedure or requirement that the Requesting Party wishes to be followed in executing the request and the reasons therefore;
- (c) in the case of requests for the search and seizure, a statement indicating the basis for belief that items may be found in the jurisdiction of the Requested Party;
- (d) in the case of requests to take evidence from a person, a statement as to whether sworn or affirmed statements are required, and a description of the subject matter of the evidence or statement sought;
- (e) in the case of lending of exhibits, the person or class of persons who will have custody of the exhibit, the place to which the exhibit is to be removed, any tests to be conducted and the date by which the exhibit will be returned.
- (f) in the case of making detained persons available, the person or class of persons who will have custody during the transfer, the place to which the detained person is to be transferred and the date of that person's return;
- (g) any other information which may be brought to the attention of the Requested Party to facilitate the execution of the request.
