\$3.5 million to the UNAIDS program and expects to make a similar contribution in 1997–98. CIDA and Health Canada contribute jointly to the global fight against tuberculosis.

For the latest five-year funding period (1993–98), the Canadian government, through Health Canada, will have allocated \$203.5 million to Canada's National AIDS Strategy, or \$40.7 million annually. Almost half of the annual amount (\$17.8 million) was earmarked for research and monitoring.
