## Reservations for Existing Measures and Liberalization Commitments

## Schedule of Canada

1. Investment Canada Act, R.S.C. 1985, c. 28 (1st Supp.)

These measures deal with the acquisition and establishment of businesses by non-Canadians and state that the establishment of new businesses by non-Canadians may be subject to review. They are reserved from the obligations imposed by Articles 4, 8 and 9.
