PRAYERS

Mr. Watson, from the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development, presented the First Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Thursday, January 21, 1971, your Committee has considered Bill C-193, An Act to amend the Northern Canada Power Commission Act, and has agreed to report it with the following amendment:

Clause 3

Add after Section 10 in clause 3, on page 2, the following new sub-section:

(10a) For purposes of establishing rates the Commission shall divide the areas served by the Commission in the Northwest and Yukon Territories into two or more rate zones.

The Committee has ordered a reprint of Bill C-193, as amended.

A copy of the Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence relating to Bill C-193 (*Issues Nos. 5 to 9 inclusive, and 14, 15 and 16*) is tabled.

The House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Lang (Saskatoon-Humboldt), seconded by Mr. Olson,—That Bill C-244, An Act respecting the stabilization of prairie grain sale proceeds and to repeal or amend certain related statutes, be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Agriculture.
