The Clerk of the Senate read the titles of the Bills to be assented to, as follows:—

An Act to amend the Old Age Security Act

An Act respecting the use of the expression "Parliament Hill"

An Act to amend the Pension Act, the War Veterans Allowance Act, the Civilian War Pensions and Allowances Act, the Children of War Dead (Education Assistance) Act and the Department of Veterans Affairs

Act to provide for the annual adjustment of pensions and allowances payable thereunder.

To these Bills the Royal Assent was pronounced by the Clerk of the Senate in the following words:—

"In Her Majesty's name, the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General doth assent to these Bills."

The Commons withdrew.

After which the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor General was pleased to retire.

The sitting of the Senate was resumed.

The Honourable Senator Langlois moved, seconded by the Honourable Senator McIlraith, P.C.,

That the Senate do now adjourn.

The question being put on the motion, it was—
