SUMMER ESSAYS and SUMER READING. ( Continued. ) Failure to submit a summer essay on time is regarded as a failure in that subject. Fourth year students deficient in summer essays, but with no prerequisite conditions, are allowed the option of handing in their essays as special supplementals at the end of the Christmas holidays. Students having the option of summer reading or submitting a summer essay, and failing in the first choice exercised, are, if they exercise the alternative, regarded as making a second attempt. The third attempt of any kind is subject to a 10.00 fee and a passing standard of sixty per cent. (Oct. 21, 1925.)
