Dear *Sir Arthur Currie* .

Between the 3rd and 10th of September 1924 the Ninety Second Meeting of the British Association for the advancement of Science will be held in Toronto .

At a meeting of the Local General Committee of this Association it was agreed that certain Local Associate Committees should be formed

It was further unanimously agreed to invite certain Gentlemen to convene general meetings of such persons as would be interested, for the purpose of organising Local Associate Committees of the British Association within their districts . These Gentlemen or others chosen at the meeting convened by them, should then become Chairmen of the Committees thus formed .

As you will see from the list enclosed, your name was proposed for your District .

I am now writing formally to ask you if you will be kind enough to assist us in the matter .

Should you agree, we shall send you information in outline as to the scope, organisation and general duties of such Associate Committees together with a resumé of our own progress to date .

In all probability, members of the British Association will visit your district so that questions will arise as to accommodation, entertainment, visits to important centres or to places of interest .

It will be of the greatest advantage to Canada, as I am sure you will agree, that wide interest in next year's meeting be aroused . Our General Committee will rely upon its Local Associate Committees to do all in their power to enhance local interest .
