VII.

Re COMMITTEE ON ESTIMATES.

Mr. R. G. McBeth moved, seconded by Mr. C. W. Gordon :—"That this Assembly appoint a Committee on Estimates, Eastern and Western Sections, and that all Committees and Boards requiring money from the Church be requested to report to said Committee not later than the 1st day of June annually, the amounts they require for their respective departments, and that the Committee on Estimates take these reports into consideration and submit to the Assembly their judgment as to the estimate that should be adopted in each case, with due regard to the needs and importance of each department and the welfare of the whole."

It was moved in amendment by Mr. H. MacKellar, seconded by Mr. J. A. Turnbull :—"That the whole matter be set down for the consideration of the Presbyteries of the Church and report to the next Assembly."

The amendment was carried and affirmed as the judgment of the house. See p. 57.

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
