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FEAR HOGS WILL HURT CORN

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CROP FEARS SLOW UP BUSINESS IN THE WEST

Country Merchants in Some Districts Inclined to Hold Off Buying.

It is stated that reports of a partial crop failure have caused a tightening up in the market for wheat and other crops. A considerable number of orders have been cancelled. In this connection a decline of more than 20 per cent in the price of wheat has been reported.

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FROST AT SASKATOON.

Saskatoon, Sask., July 26.—About two degrees of frost were registered this morning in this district. As yet it has had no blackening effect on the crop of wheat which may escape damage. Frost caught potatoes and garden truck slightly.

FIRE LOSS \$30,000 BY BLAZE AT GALT

Galt, July 26.—Loss estimated at \$30,000 was caused by a fire this morning in the Galt block, King St. north of the Market. The fire started in a room on the second floor of the block, which is now being used as a section of the business district. The situation for a time looked so serious that the fire department was called in and rendered valuable aid in getting the fire under control.

Bird has been admitted to bail until the fall court.
