YORK COUNTY AND SUBURBS

Slaughter House and Packing Factory in Connection With Union Stock Yards Completed.

COUNCILOR SECURES HARD COAL

Will be Sold at \$7 a Ton on the Siding—Sale of Soft Coal Relieves Situation.

Amended Proposition From English Colonizing Syndicate—Small-pox in Amherstburg.

Toronto Junction, Jan. 16.—The Union Stock Yards Company, in response to a contract for the construction of a slaughter house and packing factory, has in the incredibly short space of two weeks, carried to completion a building 40 x 140, which will be ready for occupation on Tuesday of next week. Twenty 20 men have been employed putting down the floor, which is of pine, tongue and groove; others are putting on the feet roofing, and the slaughter house is being fitted with a sink in the centre and a contrivance which drains the blood into a large vat situated outside the building. This will be used by market gardeners as a fertilizer. The packing room is 60 x 40, and the cold storage department 40 x 30. Bins will be ready for use on Tuesday. Outside the building piles of oak cases. When slaughtered the cattle will be packed in this way and sent to the cold storage. They are a class of stock which do not require any special treatment for the fresh meat trade, and on this account the arrangement of such a firm in connection with the stock yards will be a great acquisition, as there will always be a ready market for the cooler grades, and the buildings will have no difficulty in disposing of the stock. The new industry located at the corner of Argyle-road and Toronto-street has been given a boost by the sale of soft coal at \$3.50 per ton. Within the next few days there will probably be hard coal for sale in response to a contract of Councilor Howell at the last meeting of Council and resolution was passed authorizing the Clerk to write Buffalo coal dealers for a quotation on soft coal. Councilor Howell established a municipal coal and wood yard along the line suggested last week, and his query was considered premature. The Buffalo coal dealers, however, in reply to his letter was headed off by Councilor Howell telephoning to Buffalo. The result of the conversation with the Buffalo dealers was the shipment of a car of hard coal, which is being used by the city. Councilor Howell expects to sell the coal on the same terms as the Buffalo coal, and he has no doubt, he would have more purchasers than he could care to supply. As the Council did not appoint a committee to get prices with a view to purchase, Councilor Howell's promptness in taking the initiative in the matter, and purchasing coal at his own risk will be appreciated as a public benefaction by the many citizens who are just now looking for cheap fuel.
