### 20,000 BRITISHERS WANTED FOR ARMY IN UNITED STATES

Recruiting Mission Begins Drive for These.

250,000 YET AVAILABLE

Altogether Nearly 300,000 Will Become Liable to Draft Soon.

NEW YORK, Feb. 17 .- "The British and Canadian recruiting mission is beginning a special drive to get 20,000 men from the United States in the next men from the United States in the next two months," said Gen. W. A. White, head of the mission, today. "At mist sight this seems unnecessary, in view of the fact that the draft recruiting convention is about to be signed between the United States and Great Britan whereby all British subjects in the United States between the ages of 20 and 40 (both inclusive) will be subject to draft into the American army.

Only 20,000 Taken.


There are approximately 190,000 Dritishers and Canadians of American draft age in the United States today. These men have actually registered their numbers under the American draft. There are at least 100,000 more Britishers and Canadians between the ages of 31 and 41, so that the lowest estimate, there are 290,(10 Britishers and Canadians who will become liable to draft into the American army when the convention is signed. Out of this number the British and Canadian recruiting mission has actually enlisted 20,000 man and rejected 15,000.

"Two months after the signing of the convention these men will have the copportunity of joining the British or Canadian army, and I intend to get 20,000 volunteers during this period, if it can be done."
