NEWS NOTES OVER STOCK BROKERS' WIRES

(J. M. Robinson & Sons' private Wire Telegram.) New York, Nov. 15—Three federal judges in New York city uphold constitutionality of war time dry law. Secretary Wilson suggests 30 p. c. increase to miners, but no thirty hour week. Both sides believe settlement of wage dispute in sight. House adopts demands of railway unions for settlement of railway labor disputes by eliminating anti-strike proposals in each bill—creates three ad-judicate and three appeal boards with em-ployees on each. Dun's review says readjustment of over extended speculative position has been made for more wholesome conditions in securities markets and rescinding of coal strike order has strengthened business prospects. Reports from Youngstown, Ohio, say general wage increase of about 20 p. c.
