

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE RE:

No. 2 District Depot, C.A.

Major N.M. Menzies, 26th Canadian Army Tank Bn.
(G&SF), No. 2 District Depot, C.A. thereupon warned the
accused in accordance with Rules of Procedure 4 (e) as
follows:-

"Do you wish to make any statement or to give
evidence upon Oath?" You are not obliged to say anything
or to give evidence unless you wish to do so, but whatever
you say or any evidence you give will be taken down in
writing and may be given in evidence. "

The accused replied " I wish to make a state-
ment under Oath."

The accused , Gunner Harry Edgar Graham (RCA)
having been duly sworn, stated as follows:-

"The reason that I went absent without leave
was because my brother had just come back from overseas.
He was in Chorley Park Military Hospital, and I asked for
a pass to go see him. The pass was refused me, and I
went without one. I went back about two weeks later, and
my unit had gone away, and I did not know where to find it."
