

The witness is re-examined by the Defending Officer:

Q.457 My friend has compared light flu and heavy flu. What do you do if a man is seriously sick?
A.457 I visit him as often as possible.

Q.458 I mean a real sick man.
A.458 We visit the man and if he is not suitable to be handled in the unit we send him to some other place.

Q.459 Where?
A.459 FDS or hospital.

Def Offr: I think the Court would be interested in seeing that diary a little closer and I wonder if you would just bring it up and explain and if there are other parts of the diary in other places.

The diary referred to in the evidence of the witness above is shown to the Court.

The witness is questioned by the Court:

Q.460 You didn't keep it every day?
A.460 No sir.

The witness is questioned by the Judge Advocate:

Q.461 Is that a medical diary?
A.461 Personal sir.

Q.462 Are all your medical cases in there?
A.462 Some of them, but not all of them.

Q.463 How many medical cases have you got in there?
A.463 I wouldn't even hazard a guess, sir.

Q.464 I mean about ten - or fifteen?
A.464 Probably every officer in the unit.

Q.465 It looks more like a personal diary showing the trips to Gronigen.
A.465 It is pretty personal.

Q.466 How long have you been in the Army?
A.466 Since September 1943.

The witness is questioned by the President:

Q.467 You mentioned that you didn't see him on the Twenty-Fifth?
A.467 I was supposed to go and see him on the Twenty-Fifth.

Def Offr: May we clear that point up sir. What day he actually saw Captain Jessop?

Pros: He says that the reason he didn't see him that evening was because the bridge was out.

At the request of the Court, the following evidence of the accused was read back by the shorthand writer:

"After this discussion took place, I wasn't feeling well and went over to the mess. I laid around the mess all day until shortly after dinner which was served at six o'clock and then I went to bed. The MO came up to see me that evening and he told me that I had a slight touch of the flu and he told me to stay in bed for the remainder of the week, which I did."
