V. The Officers of the Society shall be elected as follows:— Any member may nominate a candidate for each office, in succession; and in the event of more than one nomination for any

one office, the decision shall be by ballot.

VI. The President, and Vice-Presidents, shall not be eligible for re-election to the offices respectively filled by them, for the next succeeding year.

VII. The General Annual Meeting of the Society shall be

holden on the third Friday in January of each year.

VIII. In each year there shall be holden four Quarterly General Meetings, viz: 1st. "The Annual General Meeting," and one each on the First Friday of the months of April, July, and October.

IX. Monthly Ordinary Meetings shall be held on the First Friday of each month throughout the year, excepting in January, April, July, and October, as otherwise provided under

Article No. 8.

X. Any gentleman desirous of joining the Society, shall at a General or Ordinary Meeting, be proposed and seconded by members, and may be elected by a majority of such meeting.

XI. The Annual Subscription of members shall be Ten Shillings. The subscription year shall be from 1st January to 31st December. Any new member elected between the 1st January and 30th September, shall pay the full subscription for the current year; any elected on or after 1st October, may be admitted on paying for the current quarter only.

XII. A subscription of Five Pounds shall be a Life Subscription; and the same shall be invested at interest, as a permanent fund for the charitable purposes of the Society.
