

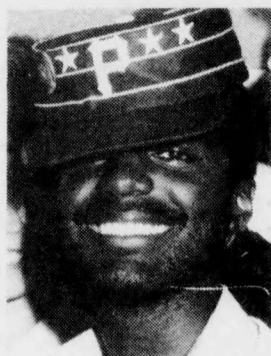

SMOKING REGULATIONS

Smoking is prohibited in certain areas of the University's buildings to reduce the danger of fire, prevent damage to floors and furnishings, and in recognition of the potential health hazard, and the rights of non-smokers. These areas include classrooms, lecture rooms, teaching laboratories, theatres or areas used as theatres, storage areas, library reading and stack rooms, gymnasiums, shop and service areas where woodworking and painting are carried out, elevators, and any other areas where "No Smoking" signs are displayed.

The University Fire Marshal, A3 Temporary Office Building, York Campus (3351) will provide assistance in the interpretation or enforcement of these regulations, and will also advise on the fire safety regulations governing potentially hazardous areas. Students encountering instances of non-compliance with the Regulations may if they prefer report these to the CYSF office, 105 Central Square at the York Campus, or to the Student Union Office, York Hall, at the Glendon Campus which will convey this information to the University Fire Marshal for appropriate action.
