Since my letter of the 24th Ult^o to
 your Honour, I have been informed that
 the Camden sailed from Amherstburg last
 Saturday (26th Ult^o) and Mr. Selby the Asst^{nt}
 Secy on board, should he not arrive
 before the Duke of Kent sails for York,
 Lieut. Col. Proctor has been so good as to say
 that she shall return here for the purpose
 of taking me over to York when Mr. Selby
 arrives. It will be some days before
 the Indians can be assembled as many of
 them are on the River Thames and others
 on the head waters of the Grand River.
 runners go off this day for the purpose
 of calling them together at the Credit, to com-
