Your Grace will observe, from that letter, that the Indian Nations, to which, bolomet clase-- kay refers me, are, for the Mash part, resident, within the limits of the United States; and will se the necessity, of cautioning belond Mackay, again any proceedings, with respect to them, which are not Streetly consistant with the friendly Pelations, subsisting between this Country and the United States. you will particularly inculcate upon him, the duty, of expressing to them on all accasions the ancious disire of this Majesty that they should lay aside every hostile feeling, towards the american Government & remain quietly upon the lands belonging to them, - you will have - ever exercise, your own discretion, as to affording them, when they come again to Drummonds Island
