With reference to Agent Gagnon's letter, perunder, of the 14th instant, I beg to state that he might properly visit Escoumains as soon as may be convenient, but with regard to Seven Islands, it appears that, although this reserve has not been taken out of Mr. Gagnon's Agency, Mr. W.D.B. Scott has been actually performing the duties of Agent in connection with that reserve, especially arranging land matters which he is now attending to; he has also been lately sent down there to attend to matters relating to small-pox and diphtheria.
