Dear Senator Meighen,

I have just returned from the West and in my mail I found awaiting me your letter of the 17th instant, written from Toronto, with regard to the purchase of a tractor for the Six Nations Reserve near Brantford.

The Department recently invited prices for such a machine and tenders were sent to the Indian Council for consideration. I am not in a position to state definitely if a tractor will be purchased as much will depend upon the willingness of the Ontario Government to contribute one-half of the cost. Your remarks on behalf of Trucks and Tractors Limited, of Ottawa, have been noted.
