MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRIME MINISTER:

Discreet enquiries were made in the Department of Labour with respect to accounts of riots in Winnipeg, in 1919, as contained in The Labour Gazette. The only references in The Gazette to the Winnipeg strike are to be found in the June and July numbers of 1919, and they do not contain any mention of Mr. Woodsworth. Unfortunately, it has not been possible to obtain any unbound copies of these numbers of The Labour Gazette. The copies attached have been borrowed from the Department of Labour, and they have specially requested that they be returned, as they are the only unbound copies the Department has.
