was a more formal acknowledgement thereof and did not entitle the Company to enter into possession.

In view of representations made by the Chiefs of the Band, as contained in letter addressed you on the 18th instant, the Department considers that if this sale is carried out, it should be on the condition that a reservation is made of the water frontage of lot 3 in the second concession and all necessary rights to cross this lot in connection therewith, and on this understanding the balance of the cash payment may be accepted by you.
