I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant in reference to the erection of the closets in connection with the Golden Lake School.

In reply I beg to say that, in view of the good work that has been performed on this building by the contractors and the fact that there have up to the present time been no extras whatever in the building, the Department is prepared to allow an additional payment of \$25.00. In view of the fact that the plans submitted by the Department for these closets would be more elaborate than those figured on by the contractors. When making your final certificate you will be good enough to show this amount as an extra, stating for what it is allowed.
