First Witness
for the
Prosecution

K-46960 Sgt Downes, R.G., 1st Bn C. Scot R. (Cda),
having been duly sworn states:

"I am K-46960 Sgt Downes, R.G., of "B" Coy
1st Bn C. Scot R. (Cda). In the field at
approximately 1745 hours, 3 AUG 45, I was Coy
Orderly Sergeant of "B" Coy and the suspicion
of theft of 300 cigarettes, the property of
K-607291 Pte Hansen, G., was reported to me by
Cpl Gaudet. Upon receiving this information I
endeavored to contact the Orderly Officer. The
Orderly Officer was apparently at supper, so I
contacted the Regimental Police Sergeant and
informed him of the situation. I was present
when the R.P. Sergeant ordered the A/QMS to
have Pte Quaw display the contents of his kit
bag on the floor. The kit bag was not completely
emptied, so the A/QMS was directed to empty the
contents of the bag properly on the floor, when
it was found to contain a carton of 300 cigarettes
with Pte Hansen's name on it.

The accused declined to cross-examine the witness.
