KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that We, the undersigned Chief and Principal men of the Chemainus Band of Indians, resident on our reserve between Oyster Harbour and Chemainus Bay, in the Province of British Columbia and Dominion of Canada, for and acting on behalf of the whole people of our said Band in Council assembled, do hereby release, remise. surrender, quit claim and yield up unto our Sovereign Lord The King, his heirs and successors forever, ALL AND SINGULAR the merchantable timber on that portion of the Chemainus Indian reserve number thirteen, in the Province of British Columbia and Dominion of Canada, containing eighteen hundred and fifty acres more or less and described as follows, - Commencing at a point on the shore of Chemainus Bay distant one hundred and four chains and ninety-eight links south and seventy-seven chains east from the northwest corner of the Chemainus Indian reserve number thirteen; thence west one hundred and thirty-seven chains more or less to the most westerly boundary of the said reserve; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary twenty-five chains more or less to the northerly side of the top of the Timber Ridge paralleling Oyster Harbour; thence southeasterly along the said northerly side of the top of the said Ridge one hundred chains more or less to the shore of Oyster Harbour: thence northerly and easterly along the shore to the westerly boundary of the property of R. Highes; thence northerly along the west boundary of the said property nine chains and forty-four links more or less; thence easterly along the north boundary and the north boundary produced thirty chains; thence south thirty-eight chains more or less to the shore of Oyster Harbour; thence southerly and easterly along the said shore to the intersection of the south boundary of the said Indian reserve with the shore of Oyster Harbour; thence easterly along the said
