Preamble.

WHEREAS the Acts now in force relating
to the exportation of Lumber are found
inconvenient,

I. *Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly,* That an Act made and passed in the thirty-seventh Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for regulating the exportation of Fish and Lumber, and for repealing the Laws now in force regulating the same"---and an Act made and passed in the forty-third Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to explain and amend an Act, intituled "An Act for regulating the exportation of Fish and Lumber, and repealing the Laws now in force regulating the same"---and also an Act made and passed in the fiftieth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to explain and amend the Laws now in force for regulating the exportation of Fish and Lumber"---and also an Act made and passed in the fifty-fourth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act in addition to an Act, intituled "An Act for regulating the exportation of Fish and Lumber, and for repealing the Laws now in force regulating the same"---also an Act, made and passed in the fifty-sixth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act in addition to, and to explain an Act, intituled "An Act to explain and amend the Laws now in force for regulating the exportation of Fish and Lumber," so far as the same relate to the article of Lumber,---be, and the same are hereby repealed:
