## CAP. V.

An ACT to prevent bringing INFEC-TIOUS DISTEMPERS into the City of Saint John. Passed the 12th MARCH, 1796.

I. And all Masters or Commanders of Vessels, and others, who shall disobey such direction and appointment, or shall, without License first had and obtained from the aforesaid Mayor, Recorder and Aldermen, or any two of them, put on shore or unlade, or affist in putting on thore or unlading any. Persons or Goods from any fuch Vessel as aforesaid, before the time mentioned in such direction or appointment is expired, shall forfeit and pay the sum of Two Hundred Pounds current money of this Province, for each offence.
