

Mr. Pardo Holds West Kent

Conservative Candidate went Down to Defeat after a Gallant Battle—The Figures so far as Received.

RETURNS FOR KENT COUNTY

Pardo's Majority is 236 According to the Returns.

There was a real hot time in the old town last night. Liberal-Conservative disappointment at the defeat in West Kent was largely offset by the victorious elsewhere. On the other hand, the Liberals, although they felt tolerably sure of Pardo's success, did not feel much like celebrating on account of the way the Province was going.

Some enterprising vendors peddled tin horns on the street and the din soon became continual while firecrackers and vigorous lungs were at times brought into play.

Thousands of people trooped up and down, looking for the news that was not obtainable. It was well on into the night before the last returns were received.

Almost immediately on the close of the polls a large throng of citizens of both parties gathered at the Pardo office to hear the returns. As soon as the messages from all the polling sub-divisions were received The Planet extra was issued announcing Mr. Fraser's majority in the city at 27. This was the only accurate and complete city returns published. The announcement occasioned much disappointment to the Conservatives, while the Liberals were correspondingly jubilant. The demand for early Planet extras from all parts of the city kept the presses hustling.

A little later the returns from the country began to arrive and were bulletined at The Planet. The early returns from the townships showed that Mr. Fraser was making steady gains and created considerable enthusiasm. It was felt, however, that the set-back received in the city could not be overcome.

Later reports confirmed this view, and the Conservatives reluctantly conceded Mr. Pardo's election.

ORFORD GIVES

BIG MAJORITY

Harwich Promises to Give Mr. Davidson Substantial Majority—Howard Scored Fourteen.

Owing to the delay in receiving the returns from the election in East Kent, The Planet is unable to give a definite statement as to the result. It appears, however, from such information as has been received that tremendous inroads have been made in the late Robert Ferguson's majorities. Mr. Lee, at present, however, seems to enjoy a safe lead in the race for supremacy.

From present appearances Harwich will give Davidson substantial support. Even the very meagre returns, which have come to hand, it would appear that John has not proven to be a very serious factor in the contest. The reports from the places yet to hear from, however, will not change the situation of affairs.

The most noticeable changes in the reports so far received are in Howard where completed returns show a majority of 14 for Davidson. This township in the last Provincial elections gave Ferguson a majority of 112. A similar showing has been made in Ridgetown, where Mr. Ferguson's majority has been reduced from 34 to 33 for Mr. Lee.

Orford, Mr. Lee's own township, only gives an increase in the Liberal majority of about 9. No reports have yet been received from Zone or Camden, so that with so many polling sub-divisions to hear from, it is quite impossible to state any definite result. Thamesville gives Davidson a majority of 9, while Bothwell, the home of Mr. John, gives Mr. Lee a majority of 11. Thamesville, which has been won by Davidson, this time, gave Ferguson in the last election a majority of 88. In Dresden Mr. Davidson has increased the Conservative majority 22.
