Land Commissioners' Court.

A. E. HOLLAND, Esq., before the Court.—Questioned by Capt. Palmer. You reside in Bedeque? Yes. Can you give any information respecting the price of lands? I can; as I hold a small portion on Lots 25, 26, 27 and 28.

Capt. Palmer.—What quantity of land do you hold altogether?

Capt. Palmer.—What can you say, then, about the price of land?

Mr H.—In the first place, I do not acknowledge the power of the Commissioners to interfere with the rights of private property; but admit that they may exercise their right and power of surveying and levelling, and of assessing and valuing land, and other representations as they may think proper.

Mr H.—I am a native of Ireland, and my father was a tenant of land on Lot 25, we are dependent upon the annual income thus derived in a great measure for our subsistence; and I consider it would be an act of great injustice were we to be compelled to pay a sum equivalent to twice what we paid for our lands at less price than 20s. per acre.

The lands which I hold ought in some measure to be accounted Loyalist land, and my rights thereon should be accordingly. My father, Major Holland, was a resident in Nova Scotia during the Union Government, and the author of the American Revolution, while he owned a large estate.

When it was determined to take up arms against Great Britain, he was offered one of the first commands in the American Army; but refusing, he was called an imprudent, and a man who had no business to be in America, and this, he maintained, caused him to be sent into active service in support of the authority of the British Crown. I feel a delicacy in entering more fully into an account of the services of my grandfather as a loyal subject of the British Crown; but will rather place in his hands the history of the revolution, and those events which they are a history of Colonial history.

I believe the grant of Township 25 was invalid. My father brought out a number of Germans to the Island, who settled upon it, and their descendants are now the most numerous people in the Lot. I understand that the original proprietors of Township 25 are generally very comfortably settled, and many of them have made considerable sums of money, which they let out on interest.

On the living part of the Lot there are very few proprietors, and those are mostly tenants, such as John East, Rev. Mr. Thomas Bell, and a number of others, all of whom are members of the Methodist, see franchises.
