Storm Along Line.

A heavy S. E. gale, accompanied by snow squalls, was raging Thursday and yesterday along the western part of the railway, being particularly severe between Deer Lake and Grand Falls. The temperature stood at about zero, and section men and trainmen at work along the line were obliged to abandon their work. Yesterday morning there were 'combs' of snow on the railroad from Port aux Basques to the Topsails, but so scattered and light that train progress was not impeded, and the different trains worked along on schedule. To provide against any snow troubles, the Government Railway Commission are now getting the snow ploughs ready for the cross-country trains, and they will likely be attached next week to all trains moving east and west to and from Port aux Basques.
