The Copy of a Reference from the Kings most Excellent Maself a Idi aiso a Letter from the Right Honourable Lords of his Maissites most Honourable Pring Councell, to the most Reverend Fathers in God, the Lords Arch-Bishops of Canterbury and Yorke their Graces.

Archbishops of Canterbury and Yorke, doe in their feuerail Propinces proceed according to tire Lascers of the Lords of the Councell, bearing date the last of Tune 1621. 2swell in recommending Captaine Whithournes discourie concerning Menfeund land, so as the same may be distributed to the several Farishes of this Kingdome, for the incouragement of Aduenturers vato the Plantation there, As allo by furthering (in the most fauorable and effectuall maner they can) the collections to be thereupon made in all the faid Perithes, towards the charge of printing and distributing those Bookes, and the said Captaine Whithournes good indeuours, and fervice, with expence of his time and meanes in the adusacing of the faid Plantation; and his scuerall great losses received as Sea by Pyrats and otherwise, of which his Maie. sty hath beens credibly certified; And further his Maiesties pleasure is, that the said Captaine Whithourne Chall haud the ំនៃនុកនៃឃើញ of his booke for one and twenty yeares.
