EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to propose that an Agreement be concluded between the Government of Canada and the Government of Japan for the easing of the visa requirements for the temporary entry of Japanese nationals to Canada and Canadian citizens to Japan in the following terms:

- (1) Japanese nationals in possession of valid Japanese passports who are seeking entry to Canada with the intention of staying there for a period not exceeding three consecutive months, may enter Canada without obtaining a visa.
- (2) Canadian citizens in possession of valid Canadian passports who are seeking entry to Japan with the intention of staying there for a period not exceeding three consecutive months, may enter Japan without obtaining a visa.
- (3) The Government of Canada may grant extensions of the period of stay to Japanese nationals who, having entered Canada without a visa under the provisions of (1) above, desire to extend the period of stay beyond three months.
- (4) The Government of Japan may grant extensions of the period of stay to Canadian citizens who, having entered Japan without a visa under the provisions of (2) above, desire to extend the period of stay beyond three months.
- (5) This waiver of visa requirements shall not apply to Japanese nationals in possession of valid Japanese passports, who are seeking entry to Canada with the intention of seeking employment or permanent residence, of exercising a profession or other occupation or of engaging in a public entertainment (including sport) for remunerative purposes or with the intention of staying there for a period exceeding three consecutive months.
- (6) This waiver of visa requirements shall not apply to Canadian citizens in possession of valid Canadian passports, who are seeking entry to Japan with the intention of seeking employment or permanent residence, of exercising a profession or other occupation or of engaging in a public entertainment (including sport) for remunerative pur-
