

Salary and Allowances

The following are examples of salaries and allowances payable to Foreign Service Officers, Levels One and Two, proceeding on assignments abroad in September 1990.

For a single employee at FS-1 level on first assignment in Bonn:

For a single newly promoted FS-2 employee recently arrived in Budapest from Ottawa with 72 months' prior service abroad.

| Annual Salary | 44 350 per year |
| Foreign Service Premium | 6 893 per year |
| Post Differential Allowance | <u>2 730 per year</u> |
| | 53 973 per year |

For a married employee with children, senior FS-2, with 169 months' prior service abroad, recently cross-posted from Guatemala to Manila (an additional 50 per cent will be added to the Post Differential Allowance for accepting a cross-posting from one hardship post to another):

* Cost of living allowance is calculated by comparing local living costs with Ottawa.
