

PROTOCOL TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF AN INTERNATIONAL FUND FOR COMPENSATION
FOR OIL POLLUTION DAMAGE, 1971

THE PARTIES TO THE PRESENT PROTOCOL,

HAVING CONSIDERED the International Convention on the
Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil
Pollution Damage, done at Brussels on 18 December 1971;

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

For the purpose of the present Protocol:

1. "Convention" means the International Convention on the
Establishment of an International Fund for Compensation for Oil
Pollution Damage, 1971.
2. "Liability Convention" has the same meaning as in the Convention.
3. "Organization" has the same meaning as in the Convention.
4. "Secretary-General" means the Secretary-General of the
Organization.

ARTICLE II

Article 1, paragraph 4 of the Convention is replaced by the
following text:

"Unit of Account" or "Monetary Unit" means the unit of account or
monetary unit as the case may be, referred to in Article V of the
Liability Convention, as amended by the Protocol thereto adopted on
19 November 1976.

ARTICLE III

The amounts referred to in the Convention shall wherever they
appear be amended as follows:

(a) Article 4:

- (i) "450 million francs" is replaced by "30 million units
of account or 450 million monetary units";
