## DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointment:

Mr. Patrick Reid (61), born in Belfast, Northern Ireland, as Consul General in San Francisco.

Mr. Reid [Queen's University, Belfast; Royal Military College, Sandhurst] joined the Federal Government in 1962 as Director, Canadian Government Exhibition Commission. In 1964, he was Commissioner General for Canada, Triennale di Milano, Italy; in 1968, Commissioner General for Canada, Hemisfair '68 in San Antonio; in 1970, Commissioner General of Canada and Chairman of the College of Commissioners General at the 1970 World Exposition in Osaka; in 1974, Commissioner General for Canada at Expo '74 in Spokane; in 1975, Commissioner General for Canada at the World Exposition in Okinawa; from 1972 to 1978, Director General (Public Affairs), Ottawa; from 1978 to 1981, Minister (Public Affairs) in London; and, concurrently, President of the International Bureau of Expositions in Paris. Since 1981, he has been Commissioner General of the 1986 World Exposition in Vancouver. Mr. Reid replaces Mr. J.J. McCardle who has returned to Ottawa.
