

ALLOCATION OF TIME TO CONSIDER SECOND READING
STAGE OF BILL C-73

Hon. Gilles Loiselle (President of the Treasury Board and Minister of State (Finance)): Mr. Speaker, pursuant to Standing Order 78(3), I move:
