-12representing their respective faculties, and if approved by this Committee, shall be referred by it to Corporation for final decision, but no such honorary degree shall be granted if as many as five members of Corporation shall vote against it. Fees for all degrees shall be such as from time to time are fixed by the Board of Governors. Such fees must be paid before a degree is conferred and no diploma shall be given until the degree has been conferred. Degrees in Course may always be refused, if the conduct or character of the candidate be open to objection. CHAPTER IX. OF RANK AND PRECEDENCE.
