with many common and medium and in-ferior. Quality considered, there was no change in values excepting for canner cows and buils, which as a rule were about 35c per cwt. lower. Stockers and feeders were slow sale at unchanged values. Milkers and springers of the good to choice quality sold at firm prices, rang-ing all the way from \$60 to \$115 each, the built selling at \$70 to \$90. Veal calves of inferior, common and medium quality are not selling/nearly as well as they did. Choice or fancy milk-fed calves are so scarce that they sell at about the same values. Sheep and lambs came forward in lib-eral numbers. Sheep were selling at lower values, but there was little change in lamb values, especially those of choice quality.




