Dominion Will Fight so Long as She Has Dollar to Raise Men

Vancouver, Nov. 18.—Conscription will never be put into effect in Canada, according to a statement made by Hon. Robert Rogers in an address before the Canadian Club here.

"If there is one thing of which we in Canada are more proud than another," said the minister, "it is the utter and complete lack of necessity for conscription within the borders of this Dominion."

"We have the spirit of loyalty and patriotism everywhere that will win victory for our flag without our even resorting to force or compulsion, conscription, or call it what you will, for the purpose of securing men for the service of the king and empire."
