

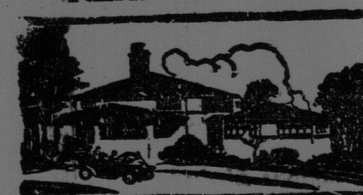

1. To authorize the City of Saint John to engage in the business of supplying electric light, heat and power, and any and all other forms of use of electrical energy to persons and corporations within the City of Saint John, the City and County of Saint John, and the Parish of Rothesay in the County of Kings.
2. To authorize the City in certain cases to take control of the whole or such part of the operations of the New Brunswick Power Company as in the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities may be necessary to provide reasonably adequate and proper services for the public.

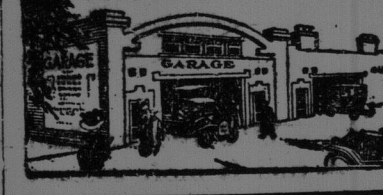
