1st Charge

COMMITTING A CIVIL OFFENCE THAT IS TO SAY ASSAULT
with intent to commit a felony; (AA Sec 41)

2nd Charge

COMMITTING A CIVIL OFFENCE THAT IS TO SAY HOUSEBREAKING
(AA Sec 41)

By direction of the Commanding Officer the evidence
is taken on oath.

The evidence of Grete Wubbenhorst, and Eilert
Wubbenhorst herein after recorded was interpreted
by 102409 Sgt Int. K v. Vrijaldenhoven
Netherlands Forces, 2/4 Canadian Provost Company
CAOF having first been duly sworn.

FIRST WITNESS:

I, GRETE WUBBENHORST, living in Tannhausen
Kreis Aurich having been duly sworn states:

At approx 0200 hrs 21 Sep 45 I was awakened
by a knocking on the door ~~at my~~ home. My Father
called to me to go and see what was the trouble.
I dressed but in the meantime I heard that the outer
door had been forced open. I hurried to the kitchen
door but before I reached it, it was also forced open.
I switched on the light and saw three Canadian soldiers
One of the soldiers, I knew as Johnny (identified as
Hull) and a second one was the accused (Fagg). I
went to my bedroom and the accused called Johnny (Hull)
followed me. The accused (Fagg) and the third
soldier left the house. I did not see the accused Fagg
again until I was outside later with Johnny. The
accused Fagg then told me I must go with him around
the corner. I refused and the accused Fagg took his
pistol pointed it at me and asked me if I was scared.
He then gave the pistol to Johnny who told me the
pistol was loaded. Johnny then ordered me to go with
the accused Fagg and fired the pistol twice. Then
they took me by the arms and led me between the build-
ings. They tried to persuade me to go with the
accused Fagg and when I refused Johnny fired the
pistol twice again. After that I still refused and
Johnny fired the pistol once over my shoulder and
once over my head. Then a third comrade came and
told Johnny to shoot me between the eyes. I was
afraid and went around the corner with the accused Fagg.
I began to cry and after talking a few minutes the
accused Fagg gave me a cigarette and told me to go
to bed. I then went into house and to bed.
