- A- Tes.
- Q- What heppened then?
- A- Lamonte started to put on his equipment.
- C- Where did DiFaclo go?
- A- He was out in the centre of the sizle.
- Q- You are positive there was no blow struck?
- A- Yes, I am positive.
- 2- With which hand was DiPacle holding Lemente's cover alls?
- A- With his left hand.
- Q- Where was his right hand?
- 1- Down by his side.
